We are asking students in your class to participate in a research study conducted by the **Learning Technologies Program (LTP)** of the Federation of American Scientists in Washington, DC, USA, in collaboration with the **Center for Technology in Teaching and Learning (CTTL)** of Rice University in Houston, Texas.
