Twitter Glossary
Hashtag #
The # symbol is used to mark keywords or topics in a Tweet.
Was created organically by Twitter users.
Put hashtags anywhere in a tweet.



Twitter Glossary
Reply
A Tweet posted in reply to another user's message, usually posted by clicking the "reply" button next to their Tweet in your timeline.
Always begins with @username.



Twitter Glossary
Retweet (RT)
Sometimes you come across a Tweet that you just have to share.
Retweeting helps you and others quickly share that Tweet with all of your followers.
